

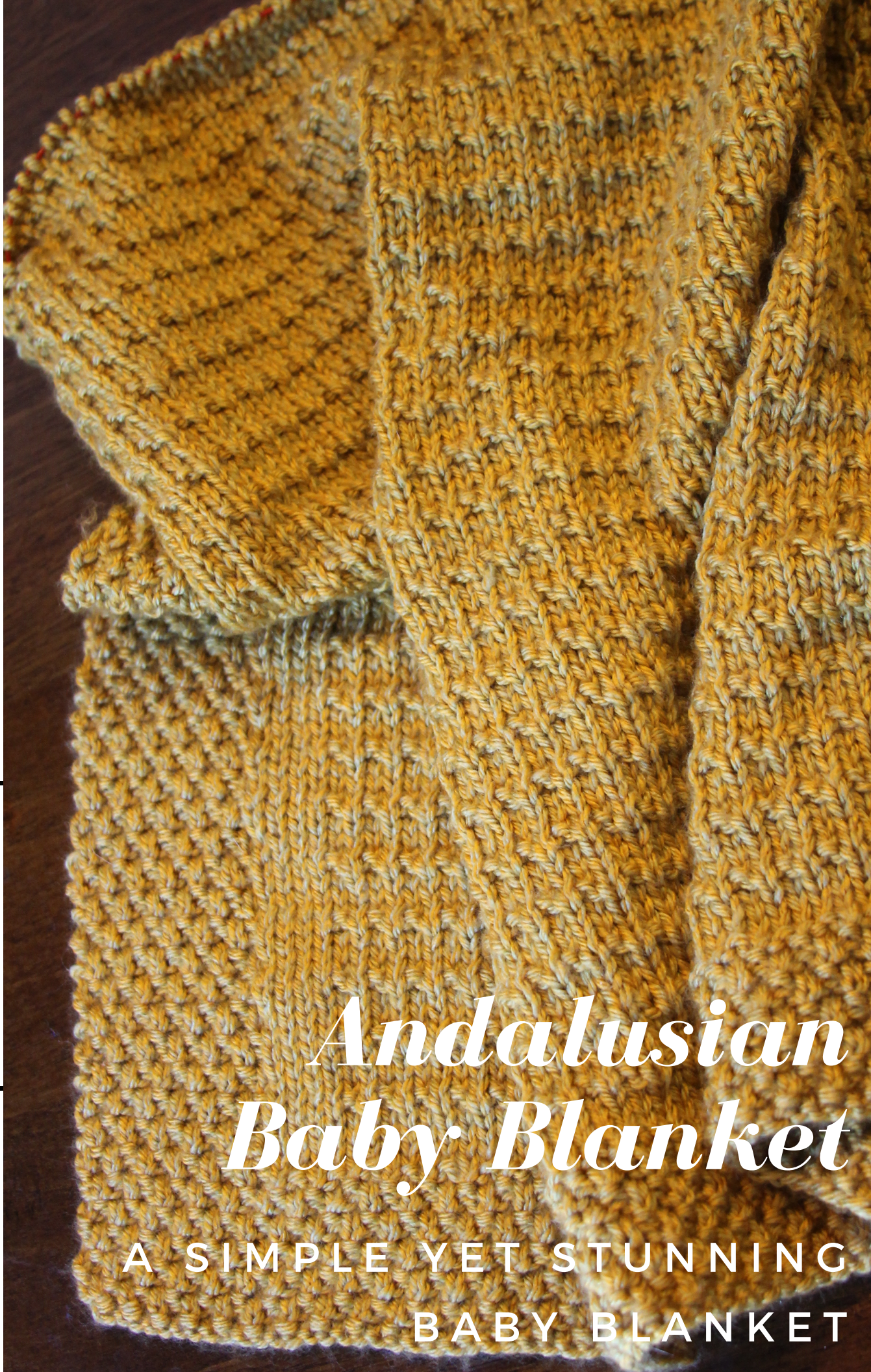

Andalusian Baby Blanket

A SIMPLE YET STUNNING
BABY BLANKET



You'll Need

TOOLS

Yarn:

Premier Everyday Anti-Pilling

Yarn Weight: Worsted/#4

4 Skeins/ 680-720 yards

Needles:

1 US Size 8/5.0mm Circular Needles, 38 inches long.

2 Stitch Markers

Potential Ribbon for Gift Wrapping

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: Bind Off

CO: Cast On

K: Knit

P: Purl

PM: Place Marker

SM: Slip Marker

STS: Stitches

Size of Blanket: 35 inches by 35 inches

Pattern Notes

Sizing: You can easily edit or change the size and shape of this blanket by adding additional stitches or rows. When changing the number of cast on stitches, keep an odd number of stitches so that the resulting pattern still works. If you choose an even number, it will throw off the Knits and Purls and not result in the double seed stitch border desired.

Choose Your Own Border: With this pattern, I've given you the option of using a double seed stitch border or a garter stitch border. Each of the following pages includes the full pattern, with one of the border options.

Gifting Tips:

Wash and dry the blanket first.

Fold in half and then in half again.

Then roll up the blanket and tie a pretty ribbon around it in a bow.

Double Seed Stitch Border Pattern

Blanket beginning:

CO 151 STS

*Do not Join, Work back and forth

Blanket Border

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat until last stitch, K1

Row 2: *K1, P1* Repeat until last stitch, K1

Row 3: *P1, K1* Repeat until last stitch, P1

Row 4: *P1, K1* Repeat until last stitch, P1

Repeat rows 1-4 Four times, or until the blanket edge measures 2.5 inches.

Internal Knitted Border

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat 6 times, PM, K to last 12 STS, PM, *P1, K1* until end of row

Row 2: *K1, P1* Rep to M, SM, P to M, SM, *P1, K1* until end of row

Row 3: *P1, K1* Rep to M, SM, K to M, SM, *K1, P1* until end of row

Row 4: *P1, K1* Rep to M, SM, P to M, SM, *K1, P1* until end of row.

Option to repeat this series of rows

Blanket Body:

Row 1: *K1, P1* Rep to M, SM, K6, *P1, K1* to 7 STS Before M, P1, K6, SM, *P1, K1* Rep to end of row

Row 2: *K1, P1* Rep to M, SM, P to M, SM, *P1, K1* until end of row

Row 3: *P1, K1* Rep to M, SM, K to M, SM, *K1, P1* until end of row

Row 4: *P1, K1* Rep to M, SM, P to M, SM, *K1, P1* until end of row.

Repeat these four rows until blanket measures 28-29 inches. End on Row 1

Repeat Internal Knitted Border

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat 6 times, PM, K to last 12 STS, PM, *P1, K1* until end of row

Row 2: *K1, P1* Rep to M, SM, P to M, SM, *P1, K1* until end of row

Row 3: *P1, K1* Rep to M, SM, K to M, SM, *K1, P1* until end of row

Row 4: *P1, K1* Rep to M, SM, P to M, SM, *K1, P1* until end of row.

If you selected to repeat this series of rows at the beginning of the blanket, work them a second time here.

Border: Same as in Beginning

Row 1: *K1, P1* Repeat until last stitch, K1

Row 2: *K1, P1* Repeat until last stitch, K1

Row 3: *P1, K1* Repeat until last stitch, P1

Row 4: *P1, K1* Repeat until last stitch, P1

Repeat rows 1-4 four times, or until the blanket edge measures 2.5 inches.

Knitted Bind Off:

Step 1: K1, Place that stitch back on the left hand needle.

Step 2: K2Tog, then place the resulting stitch back on the left hand needle

Repeat steps 1 and 2 until you have only one stitch remaining. Knot Yarn and sew in yarn tails.

Garter Stitch Border Pattern

Blanket Beginning:

CO 151 STS

*Do not Join, Work back and forth

Blanket Border Beginning

Row 1: Knit all stitches

Repeat row 1 sixteen times, or until the blanket edge measures 2.5 inches.

Internal Knitted Border

Row 1: K 12 STS, PM, K to last 12 STS, PM, K to end of row

Row 2: K to M, SM, P to M, SM, K to until end of row

Row 3: K to M, SM, K to M, SM, K to end of row

Row 4: K to M, SM, P to M, SM, K to end of row.

Repeat rows 1-4 another time

Blanket Body:

Row 1: K to M, SM, K6, *P1, K1* to 6 STS Before M, P1, K6 SM, SM, K to end of row

Row 2: K to M, SM, P to M, SM, K to end of row

Row 3: K to M, SM, K to M, SM, K to end of row

Row 4: K to M, SM, P to M, SM, K to end of row.

Repeat these four rows until blanket measures 28-29 inches. End on Row 1

Repeat Internal Knitted Border

Row 1: K 12 STS, SM, P to last 12 STS, SM K to end of row

Row 2: K to M, SM, K to M, SM, K to until end of row

Row 3: K to M, SM, P to M, SM, K to end of row

Row 4: K to M, SM, K to M, SM, K to end of row.

Repeat rows 1-4 another time

Blanket Border End

Row 1: Knit all stitches

Repeat row 1 sixteen times, or until the blanket edge measures 2.5 inches.

Knitted Bind Off:

Step 1: K1, Place that stitch back on the left hand needle.

Step 2: K2Tog, then place the resulting stitch back on the left hand needle

Repeat steps 1 and 2 until you have only one stitch remaining. Knot Yarn and sew in yarn tails.
