# *You'll Need*

## TOOLS

**Yarn:**

Big Twist: Two Skeins

Yarn Weight: Super Bulky

**Needles:**

US Size 10/6.0mm DPNs for newborn and 3-6 months

US Size 10/6mm Circular Needle for larger sizes

Darning Needle for finishing

Optional Pompom

Stitch marker

## ABBREVIATIONS

CO: Cast On

STS: Stitches

K: Knit

K1TB: Knit next stitch through the back

K2Tog: Knit two stitches together

PSSO: Pass Slipped Stitch Over

YO: Yarn Over

RT: Right Twist

Gauge: 8 STS X 10 rounds = 2X2 inches in cable pattern

# *Pattern Notes*

**Sizing:**

Newborn - 14 inch circumference and 5.5 inches tall

3-6 Months - 17 inch circumference and 6.5 inches tall

6-12 months - 18 inch circumference and 7 inches tall

12 months - 3 years: 19 inch circumference and 7.5 inches tall

Adult Small - 22 inches circumference

Adult Medium - 24 inch Circumference

Adult Large - 25 inch circumference

**K2Tog:** Knitting two stitches at the same time, a common decrease method. Inert your needle into the next two stitches and knit them.

**Mock Cables:** Slip the first knit stitch purl-wise. Knit the next two stitches. Pass the slipped stitch up and over the two knit stitches.

**Right Twist:** Identify the next two stitches on the left hand needle. Insert your right hand needle into the second stitch, and knit it. Then, knit the first stitch on the left hand needle. Now transfer them to the right hand needle and continue knitting.

# Hat Pattern

## Cast On:

Newborn: 56 Stitches  
 3-6 Months: 60 Stitches  
 6-12 Months: 72 Stitches  
 1-3 Years: 80 Stitches  
 Adult Small: 88 Stitches  
 Adult Large: 96 Stitches

Join in the round. Make sure that none of the stitches are twisted. Place Stitch marker to denote the beginning of a round.

## Brim:

Round 1: \*K1TB, P1\* Repeat until end  
 Repeat Round 1:

Newborn:

3-6 Months: 4 times

6-12 Months: 5-6 times

1-3 Years: 7 times

Adult Small: Eight times

Adult Large: Eight to Ten Times

## Hat Body:

Round 1: \*P1, K3\* Repeat to end of round.

Round 2: \*P1, RT, K1, P1, Sl1, K2, PSSO\* Repeat to end of round.

Round 3: \*P1, K3, P1, K1, YO, K1\* Repeat to end of round.

Round 4: \*P1, K1, RT, P1, K3\* Repeat to end of round

## Repeat the Rounds 3-5 until the hat measures:

Newborn: Five Inches  
 3-6 Months: 5-6 Inches  
 6-12 Months: 6-7 Inches  
 1-3 years: 7-8 Inches  
 Adult Small: 9-10 inches  
 Adult Large: 10-12 inches

## Decrease Section:

Round 1: \*P1, K2tog, K1, P1, Sl1, K2, PSSO, P1\* Repeat to end of round.

Round 2: \*K3, P1\* Repeat to end of round.

Round 3: \*P1, K2tog\* Repeat to end of round.

For Adult Hats

Round 4: \*K2Tog\* Repeat to end of round.

Round 5: \*K2Tog\* Repeat to end of round.

Break your yarn.

Grab your darning/tapestry needle and weave in your yarn tails. You have the option of adding a pompom which I personally love to do.
