RAGLAN SWEATER

Porch Goose Sweater

You'll Need

TOOLS

Yarn:

1 Skein: Loops & Threads Flecks Acrylic Blend (355 Yards), or similar medium weight yarn.
Caron Simply Soft would work well too.

Needles:

US Size 5 DPNs for neck
US Size 5 Circular Needle (16 Inches)
US Size 5 Circular Needle (32 Inches)
Darning/Tapestry Needle for finishing
2 Stitch markers

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: Bind Off
CO: Cast On
CN: Cable Needle or DPN
K: Knit
KTBL: Knit through the back Loop
P: Purl
PM: Place Marker
SM: Slip Marker
M1R: Make one Right
M1L: Make one Left
STS: Stitches

Pattern Notes

Gauge: for 2x2 inch swatch

Rib 14 STS x 16 Rounds

Stockinette Stitch: 11 STS x 16 Rounds

This pattern is designed to fit 23 inch Porch Goose.

23 Inch Goose Measurements: Neck: 8 inches

Chest: 26 inches

M1R: Pick up the bar between your stitches, inserting your left needle from back to front and knit the stitch.

M1L: Pick up the bar between your stitches, inserting your left needle from front to back, and knit through the back of the stitch.

17 Inch Goose

Rib Cuff:

Using DPNs: Cast on 52 STS

Round 1: K2, P2

Rep for for 29 more rounds

Set up round: Switching to magic loop, Knit all stitches. Place Markers:

Front: Count right to left, 5STS and PM, then 6 more STS, PM, 4 more STS and PM, 6 more STS and PM.

You have four stitches in the center and a six stitch cable marked on either side now.

Back: Repeat Process

Raglan Increase:

Round 1: *K to M, M1R, SM, C3B, SM, M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, C3F, SM, M1L,* Repeat (60)

Round 2: Knit

Round 3: *K to M, M1R, SM, K6, SM, M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, K6, SM, M1L* Repeat (68)

Round 4: Knit all Stitches

Round 5: *K to M, M1R, SM, K6, SM, M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, K6, SM, M1L* Repeat (76)

Round 6: Knit all Stitches

Round 7: *K to M, M1R, SM, K6, SM, M1L, K to M, M1R, SM, K6, SM, M1L* Repeat (84)

Round 8: Knit all stitches

Repeat this increase section: 6 additional times.

With the sweater wide enough, now we work the cable section without the increases.

Round 41: K to M, SM, C3B, SM, K to M, SM, C3F, SM,* Repeat

Round 42: Knit

Round 43: Knit

Round 44: Knit

Round 45: Knit

Round 46: Knit

Round 47: Knit

Round 48: Knit

Work this Section one more time.

Ribbed Border:

Round 1: K2, P2

Rep for 11 more rounds.

Bind Off.
